We are currently looking for a Groundskeeping Supervisor who is committed to working from April – November. The Groundskeeping Supervisor will lead a crew of 3-4 people on a daily basis, providing spring and fall clean-ups, grass cutting and litter control services for a wide range of properties.

• Supervise and direct a crew of 3-4 including transportation, training and oversight of employees in completion



of a wide variety of landscape maintenance tasks including lawn cutting and trimming, litter control, spring and fall clean-ups, weeding, hedge & tree trimming/pruning.
