About the Role

Krackers (Catering) is looking for reliable and dedicated participant-kitchen staff to join our team. As part of our social enterprise, this position offers you the opportunity to contribute to the team, gain employment experience, and learn new skills that you can apply to future employment opportunities. The ideal candidate will be detail-oriented, hardworking, and committed to providing high-quality catering services. This position will report to the Kitchen Supervisor and Operational Manager.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Assist in the preparation of ingredients for catering orders, including chopping, slicing, and portioning food items according to specifications.
- Prepare and cook a variety of dishes for catering events, ensuring food quality, portion size, and presentation meet company standards.
- Prepare and serve food to customers, handling cash or processing payments, and maintaining inventory.
- Prepare and bake a variety of items, including pastries, desserts, and snacks, ensuring freshness and quality.
- Maintain a clean and organized kitchen, including washing dishes, sanitizing surfaces, and ensuring compliance with food safety and health regulations.
- Work closely with other kitchen staff and management to ensure smooth kitchen operations and efficient order fulfillment.
- Perform other tasks as directed by the supervisor or kitchen manager, including food plating, packaging for delivery, and any special prep for catering events and clean-up.

- Ability to stand on your feet for extended periods of time.

- Experience working within a kitchen environment, catering or food industry considered an asset.
- Strong customer service skills and professional demeanor.
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs.
- Punctual, reliable and detail-oriented with strong work ethic.
